NOTES

- Econ 322 MAY NOT be counted toward a degree in economics.
- * The student taking more than one of these courses can apply them as Econ electives.
- At least 9 hours in the Minor must be 300/400 level. Up to 6 hours may come from elsewhere in the degree plan but hours must be made up in the General Elective category. Consult your advisor for minor options.
- The second speech and writing skills course should be chosen from Engl 203, 210, 235, 236, 241, 301; Comm 203 or 243.
- Six hours of English Literature electives must be chosen from 203, 212, 221, 222, 227, 228, 231 and 232. ENGL 203 MAY NOT BE USED TO SATISFY MORE THAN ONE REQUIREMENT. Upper level students must take a 300-level literature that can be substituted in for a 200-level literature to satisfy this requirement (EXCEPT Engl 360 & 361)
- KINE 199 TO BE TAKEN PASS/FAIL; KINE 198, THE HEALTH AND FITNESS COURSE, TO BE TAKEN FOR A LETTER GRADE.**

7. CHECK PREREQUISITES. Stat 211 is especially recommended for those preparing for graduate school. Stat 303 or 211 should be taken before, not concurrently, with Ecmt 463.
Note that the math prerequisites for Stat 211 are two semesters of calculus.

8. Science courses should be selected from the University Core Curriculum.

9. General electives may be selected from any courses other than economics courses, except KINE 198.

10. Economics courses will not satisfy Social and Behavioral Science requirements for majors.

This document is intended to serve as a general outline for the student to follow in order to meet the requirements for a Bachelor of Science degree in Economics. It does not constitute a contract, nor does it imply assurance of graduation. It is NOT to be used in place of a consultation with your major academic advisor.

It is the student's responsibility to consult their catalog or official degree audit at myrecord.tamu.edu and see their major academic advisor for any new updates or changes. In addition, students are required to pick up an official 95 hour degree audit during the semester after completing 95 hours.
